

Camp Guidelines

- ▶ No Personal entertainment, devices: PHONES, game systems, iPods/tablets, etc
- ▶ Everyone should be courteous and respectful to others – no swearing or foul language
- ▶ No public displays of affection or inappropriate behavior- towel snapping, suggestive touching, kissing, handholding, intimidation or threats.
- ▶ No use of or possession of tobacco, alcohol, drugs or weapons (pocket knives included). This is cause for immediate dismissal.
- ▶ We need to be a witness for Christ wherever we go so watch how your behavior and talk appears to others.
- ▶ Campers are to show proper respect to leaders and others in authority.

Dress Code

The purpose of our dress code is not to impose legalism or unnecessary rules on campers (and counselors). But is an effort to ensure that we are not causing needless distractions for others. By dressing modestly, we show love to our brothers and sisters in Christ and help provide an environment where our hearts and minds can be focused on Christ, rather than what someone is wearing. Please read the dress code and pack accordingly.

- *Clothing should be modest at all times – no 2 piece bathing suits, Speedos, no exposed midriffs, cleavage or underwear showing.
- *No short shorts - shorts should be fingertip length.
- *No spaghetti straps - Shirts must have a 2-3 finger strap width.
- *Leggings or Yoga Pants are NOT considered pants.
- *Boys must wear shirts at all times unless swimming/playing crud wars

The following three step policy is in effect for violations of these rules:

1st Step: Warning – This warning will be accompanied with promise to call a parent if there is another problem.

2nd Step: A call to a parent.

3rd Step: Dismissal (camper sent home at their own expense).
